6 Days - from New York to Niagara Falls, Toronto, Washington, Amish, Philadelphia, Manhattan

Day 1 - From new York City to Niagara Falls

Day 3 - Niagara Falls to Corning

It's time to wave goodbye to Niagara Falls and head to Corning, NY to explore its unique boutiques, antique stores, art galleries, and get a feel for the local culture. Day 4 - Washington DC
